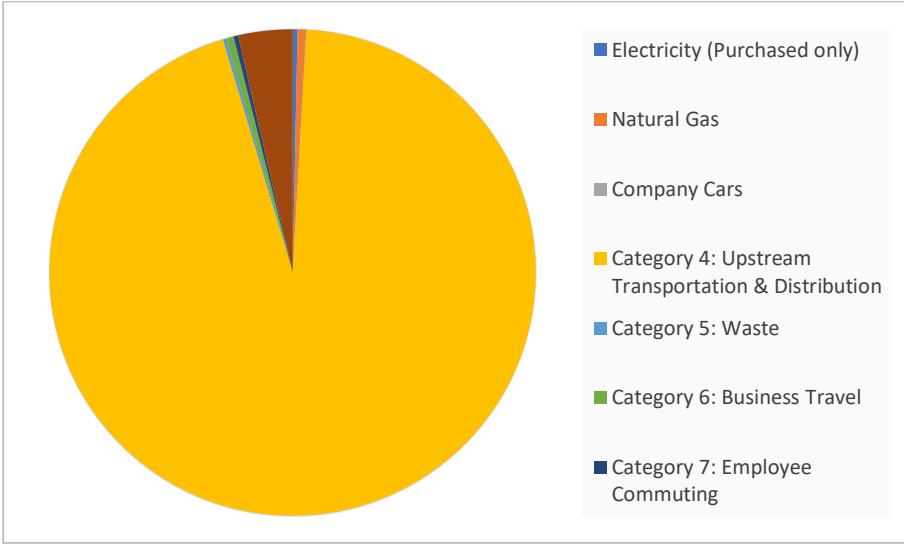
Commitment to achieving Net Zero

Baseline Emissions Footprint

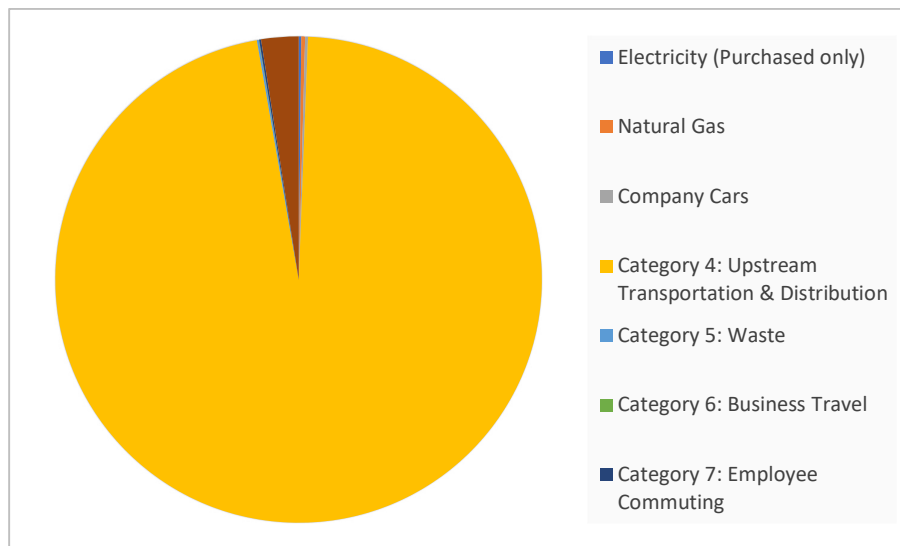
Baseline emissions are a record of the greenhouse gases that have been produced in the past and were produced prior to the introduction of any strategies to reduce emissions. Baseline emissions are the reference point against which emissions reduction can be measured.

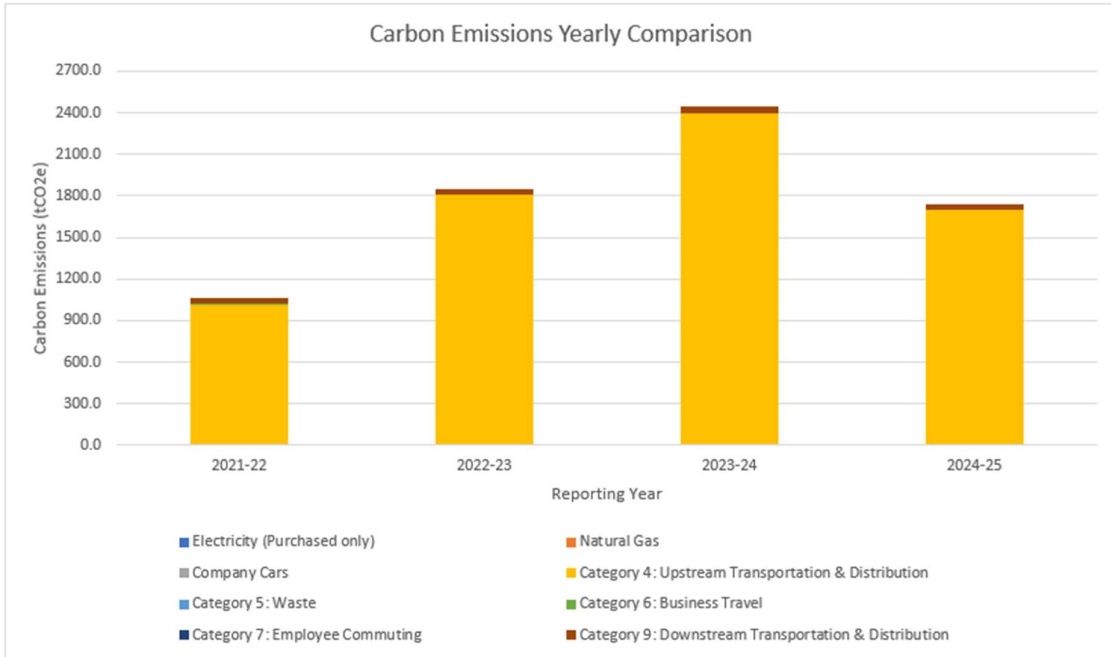
Baseline Year: 01/02/2021 – 31/01/2022	
Additional Details relating to the Baseline Emissions calculations.	
Scope 1 & 2 Our premises are leased and gas/electric usage data is supplied by the landlord. This data does not reflect our actual usage; it is pro-rated based on square footage. The site uses 100% renewable electricity; therefore, the emissions that would have been produced from electricity can be reported as zero using the market-based method.	
Scope 3 Data has been calculated using actual data from invoices, shipping logs, etc.

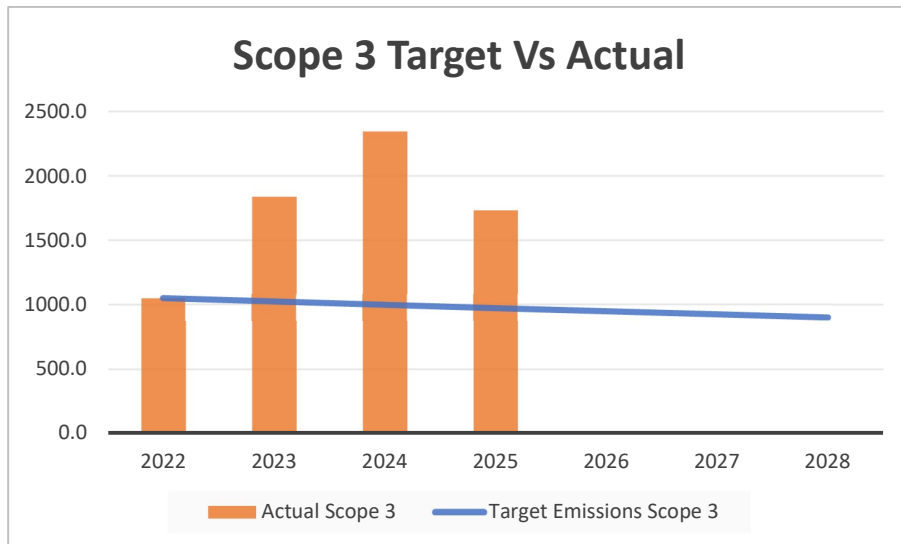
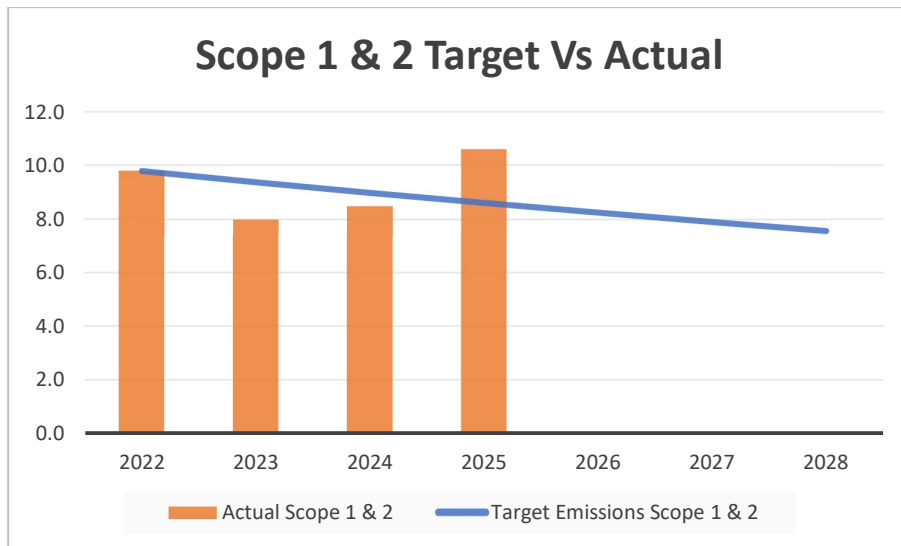


Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

For scope 1 and 2, a 4.2% linear reduction target has been applied. A 2.5% linear reduction target has been applied for scope 3.

Progress against target is summarised in the graphs below:



Carbon Reduction Projects

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the Year Ending 2022 baseline.

Project: Warehouse Lighting – Scope 2 reduction

The lighting in the warehouse was replaced and upgraded to energy efficient lighting, with motion sensors to reduce the amount of energy usage.

Project: Office Insulation – Scope 1 reduction

Roof skylights were identified as an area of heat loss in the office. Custom covers were fitted to reduce the amount of heat loss.

Project: Carbon Footprint Training

The team completed training on carbon footprint, relevant terminology, the NHS roadmap, understanding different types of emissions and how to manage them.

Future Carbon Reduction Initiatives

In the future we aim to implement further measures such as:

Project: Office Insulation – Scope 1 reduction

Review and implement further opportunities to insulate the office and reduce heat loss.

Project: Scope 1 reduction

Use of virtual meetings to reduce travel in company vehicles.

Project: Scope 3 reduction

Review purchasing practices to reduce upstream transport and distribution.

Declaration and Sign Off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.
