

Carbon Management Report: Monday 16th September 2024

Date of Carbon Report Period: **Year ended 31st December 2022**

Reynolds Catering Supplies Limited and its Group companies, collectively the Reynolds Food Group (“Reynolds”), is a national food wholesaler.

This Carbon Management Report outlines the current carbon emissions profile of our operations, establishing a baseline for future carbon reduction efforts.

Carbon Emissions

The following table presents our Scope 1, Scope 2, and Scope 3 carbon emissions for the baseline year.

These emissions have been calculated in accordance with the Greenhouse Gas Protocol (GHG), which categorises emissions into three scopes:

- Scope 1: Direct emissions from owned or controlled sources (e.g., fuel combustion in vehicles, gas boilers).
- Scope 2: Indirect emissions from the consumption of purchased electricity, heat, or steam.
- Scope 3: All other indirect emissions, including supply chain emissions (e.g., purchased goods, transport, waste).

Our measurement has been completed and reviewed by an industry-leading carbon accounting firm.

Next Steps and Net-Zero Target

The Sustainability Team, on behalf of the Group, seek to validate any net-zero targets with the Science Based Targets institute (SBTi), with a target for this to be completed by September 2025, when the emissions data for the 18-month financial period from 1st January 2024 to 31st March 2025 is planned to be complete.

In the meantime, the Reynolds Group Board (the “Board”), on behalf of the Group, are now committed to achieving net-zero Scope 1 and 2 emissions by 31st March 2035, and net-zero Scope 3 emissions by 31st March 2050.

During the validation period with the SBTi, the Board recognise that target dates might fluctuate as the Group commits to keeping warming well under 1.5°C against pre-industrial levels. Any changes will be communicated, as appropriate, to the Group’s stakeholders.
