2024 is the baseline reporting year for T. Gilmartin Ltd. In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

- Net Zero carbon across Scope 3 emissions by 2050.

Carbon Reduction Projects

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented.

2024 is a key year to put the foundations in place for our long-term sustainability strategy. As part of our commitment to reducing carbon emissions, we have established a range of initiatives designed to support both immediate and future goals. We are ISO-14001 accredited and utilise a range of ongoing measures to reduce our carbon emissions, including:

- Over 100 solar panels provide power for our Head Office, making it energy-efficient with **zero gas consumption**.
- **Sustainable waste management** through a partnership with Reconomy Ltd, diverting over **90% of waste from landfill**.
- Use of **sustainable materials** throughout our service, ensuring our procurement practices align with environmental goals.
- Operational policies focused on **reducing travel time** for field-based staff, optimising routes, and minimising unnecessary journeys.
- Integration of **digital tools and remote working** where possible to reduce the need for commuting and business travel.

In the future, we hope to implement further measures such as:

- **Increased use of electric vehicles.**
- Exploring **carbon offsetting initiatives** for remaining unavoidable emissions.
- Expanding the use of **renewable energy** across other operational sites.
- Continued partnership with supply chain partners to enhance **sustainable procurement**.
